State of Connecticut - Minimum Wage Information

Last Updated: October 24th, 2025

The following is the minimum wage through 2025.

- Effective October 1, 2019: not less than eleven dollars per hour.
- Effective September 1, 2020: not less than twelve dollars per hour.
- Effective August 1, 2021: not less than thirteen dollars per hour.
- Effective July 1, 2022: not less than fourteen dollars per hour.
- Effective June 1, 2023: not less than fifteen dollars per hour.
- Effective January 1, 2024: not less than fifteen dollars and sixty-nine cents per hour.
- Effective January 1, 2025: not less than sixteen dollars and thirty-five cents per hour.
- Effective January 1, 2026: not less than sixteen dollars and ninety-four cents per hour.
